## *Today's Message: Loving the Haters*

*The Servant King, Week 12*

Mark 14:1-26

Juxtapose: *"To place side by side, especially for comparison or contrast."*

Mark 14 presents 4 contrasting pictures of **love** and **hate**.

Picture 1: The **hatred** of religious leaders for Jesus (vv. 1-2)

- Jesus threatened their authority
- They plotted to kill Jesus

Picture 2: The **love** of Mary for Jesus (v. 3)

- Mary's anointing oil was worth \$10,000

Picture 3: The **hatred** of Judas for the way of Jesus (vv. 4-11)

- Judas was a thief
- Judas became disillusioned with Jesus

Picture 4: The **love** of Jesus for all the **haters** (vv. 12-26)

- The Passover pointed to Jesus
- Jesus body is the "bread" broken for all
- Jesus blood is "poured out for many"

### ***So What?***

3 Key Questions:

1. How are you responding to Jesus' love for you?
2. Are you fully trusting in Jesus as your only hope?
3. How are you demonstrating your love for Jesus?
