



Head outside for Midway Games to get the wiggles out after WOW Zone Bible Time. Select an activity that will work for the number of children and the ages you have. Pick from the suggested activities, or choose an activity that your kids enjoy.

DAY ONE:

Universe of Bubbles: Blow bubbles and imagine what Day 3 of Creation as God created all the planets, moons, stars and other heavenly bodies and put them each into place.

Creation Art Smarts: Use sidewalk chalk to draw pictures of things that God created. Can you remember what God created on each day?

Midway Mania: Play your favorite lawn game—corn hole, ladder ball, lawn darts, bean bag toss, basketball toss, etc.

DAY TWO:

Tall Tails: Find some old long socks, scarves or a strip of fabric—one per child. Have each child create a tail by tucking the item into a back pocket, belt loop or waistband. When you say “go”, everyone tries to grab someone else’s tail while trying to keep their own. Remind them that God gave animals tails for different reasons—swinging, climbing, balance, swimming.

Hit the Bullseye: Draw a bulls eye target with sidewalk chalk and toss beanbags; play corn hole or a similar lawn game.

DAY THREE:

Scavenger Hunt: Make a list of items that God created appropriate for your surroundings and the age of your kids. Send them out with a list and a bag or bucket. Your list could include items such as a fuzzy leaf, a blade of grass, a dead bug, something red, something yellow, something soft, something created on Day Three, etc.

DAY FOUR:

Amazement Park Trails: Use sidewalk chalk to draw curvy paths for kids to follow—they can walk or ride their scooters, trikes, or bikes. Or you can place lawn chairs, buckets or other items for them to ride around.

Take Flight! Paper airplanes might not be able to fly as well as all the amazing birds that God created, but it can be fun to try. Search the internet for some unique paper airplane designs.

DAY FIVE:

Disappearing Dino: Similar to hide and seek. One child is the dinosaur who disappears by hiding. The other children try to find the disappearing dino.

Dino Egg Toss: Play the Dino Egg Toss game that you created in Craft Cove
