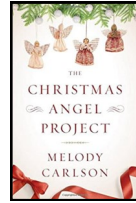

Food Pantry Project

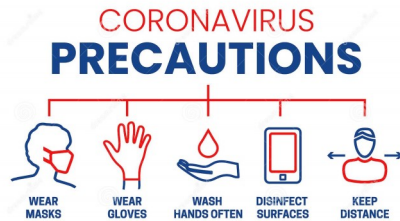
