7 Common Misconceptions About the Prayer Chain:

1. "The prayer chain is just about feeding busybodies & gossips." Wrong. The prayer chain is about prayer and genuinely loving one another.
2. "There's no filter on prayer chain requests." Wrong again. Each prayer chain request is reviewed to make sure it is appropriate for sharing.
3. "Submitting a prayer request means I'm selfish and attention-seeking." Actually, asking for prayer invites the presence of God in your life. We see the Christian life not as loners but in community with other believers who love Jesus.
4. "Prayer chain requests get plastered all over the internet." No. Prayer chain requests are only shared through email to those who request to be part of this ministry.
5. "Submitting a prayer chain request means I'm weak." That's right, we all are! That's the point: We need the Lord!
6. "Submitting a prayer chain request invites an invasion of my privacy." We are to share our needs so others can help and encourage us. Most people are really not that interested in your private matters. They just want to help.
7. "If I join the prayer chain, I'll be inundated with emails and too much information about people's personal lives." The only emails you will receive will be prayer chain requests and updates. Sometimes these are daily but usually 3-4 times per week on average.
